

BENEFIT GALA AND CARING FOR CHILDREN AWARDS

The Coalition for Asian **American Children and Families**' 30th Anniversary Benefit Gala and Caring for Children Awards brings together CACF's supporters, members, and volunteers for a moving evening of recognizing the significant achievements of our honorees and supporting CACF's work to empower youth, parents, service providers and policymakers to improve the health and wellbeing of Asian Pacific American children and families.

Our Mission

CACF is the nation's only pan-Asian children's advocacy organization, aiming to improve the well-being of Asian Pacific American children and families. We challenge the stereotypes about APAs and raise awareness about the many families in our community who are struggling with cultural differences, language barriers, and economic insecurity. We educate the community and policymakers, train youth and parents as advocates, and help health and human service professionals to better understand our vibrant, diverse community.



Why CACF?

New York City is home to over 1.3 million Asian Pacific Americans, making up 15% of the City's population and representing 32% of the city's growth since 2000. As our community has grown, so have our community's struggle with poverty, linguistic isolation, educational challenges and limited job prospects.

- Successfully advocated for a historic \$2.5 million Non Profit Stabilization Fund, in collaboration with the Community of Colors partners, to strengthen the capacities of our community organizations.
- Awarded the New York State Department of Health In-Person Assistor (IPA)/Navigator grants for the New York State of Health Marketplace to provide health insurance enrollment assistance to more than 8.000 thousand uninsured Asian Pacific Americans, speaking over 19 languages.
- Since 2004, CACF has trained and empowered over 200 Asian Pacific American youth leaders to speak out on behalf of their communities and advocate for changes in the public school system.
- CACF's POWER parent program has trained over 500 immigrant parents to advocate for their families' rights.


