CACF members will be invited to share feedback and to sign-on to letters and statements submitted to City and State policy makers.

With our members, CACF advocates for improved policies, funding, and services for Asian Pacific American children and families. CACF's Asian Pacific American (APA) **Social Justice Leadership Institute (SJLI)** will provide cohort based learning to prepare leaders to become more forward-thinking, community-connected, and long-term drives of social change. CACF member organizations will have access to exclusive cohorts, scholarships, and reduced fees.
